



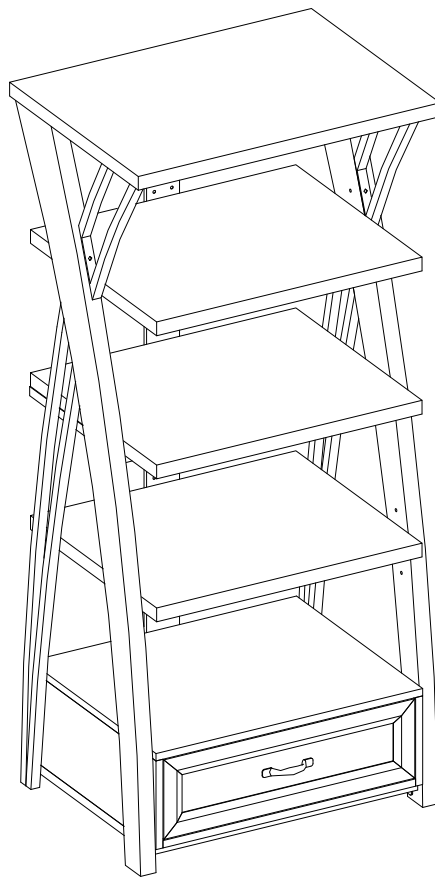

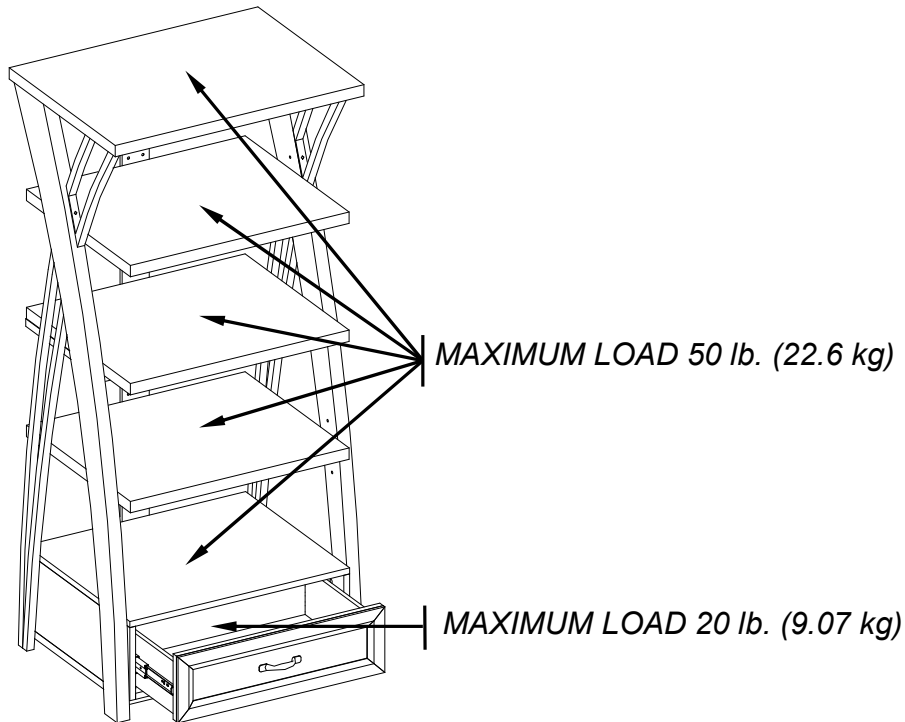

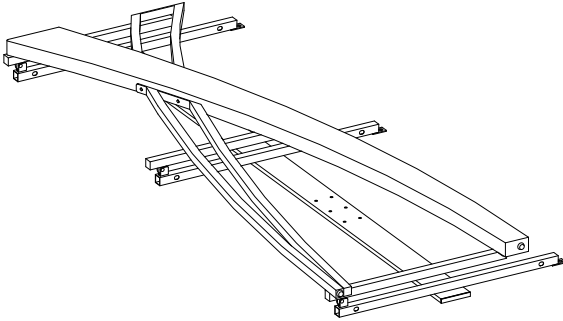
GENERAL INFORMATION, TIPS and TRICKS

1. Please read the Assembly Instructions prior to assembling this product.
2. Remove all hardware from the box and sort by size.
3. Check to see that all hardware and parts are present BEFORE assembling.
4. Ask a friend to assist you with the assembly of this furniture.
5. To avoid damage, assemble the product on a sturdy, level and protective surface.
6. Please wait until all steps are completed before fully tightening bolts.
7. Make sure all bolts are tightly fastened before the unit is used.

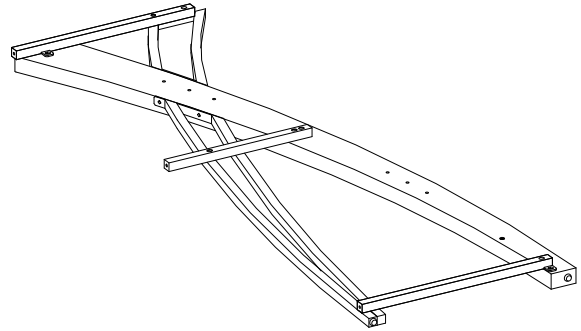
This product is sold with one set of Tipping Restraint Hardware Kit. You must install the Tipping Restraint Hardware between the wall and the tower to prevent any accidents or damages. When properly installed, this restraint can provide protection against the unexpected tipping of the unit due to small tremors, bumps or climbing. The restraint is only a deterrent and is not a substitute for proper adult supervision. Use of tip-over restraints may only reduce, but not eliminate, the risk of tip-over.

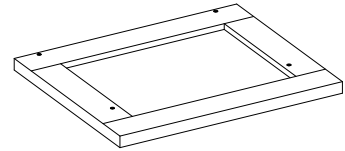

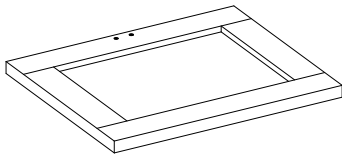

NOTE: Please do not fully tighten all bolts until you finish assembling all parts. Once assembled, go back and fully tighten all bolts. This will make the assembly easier.

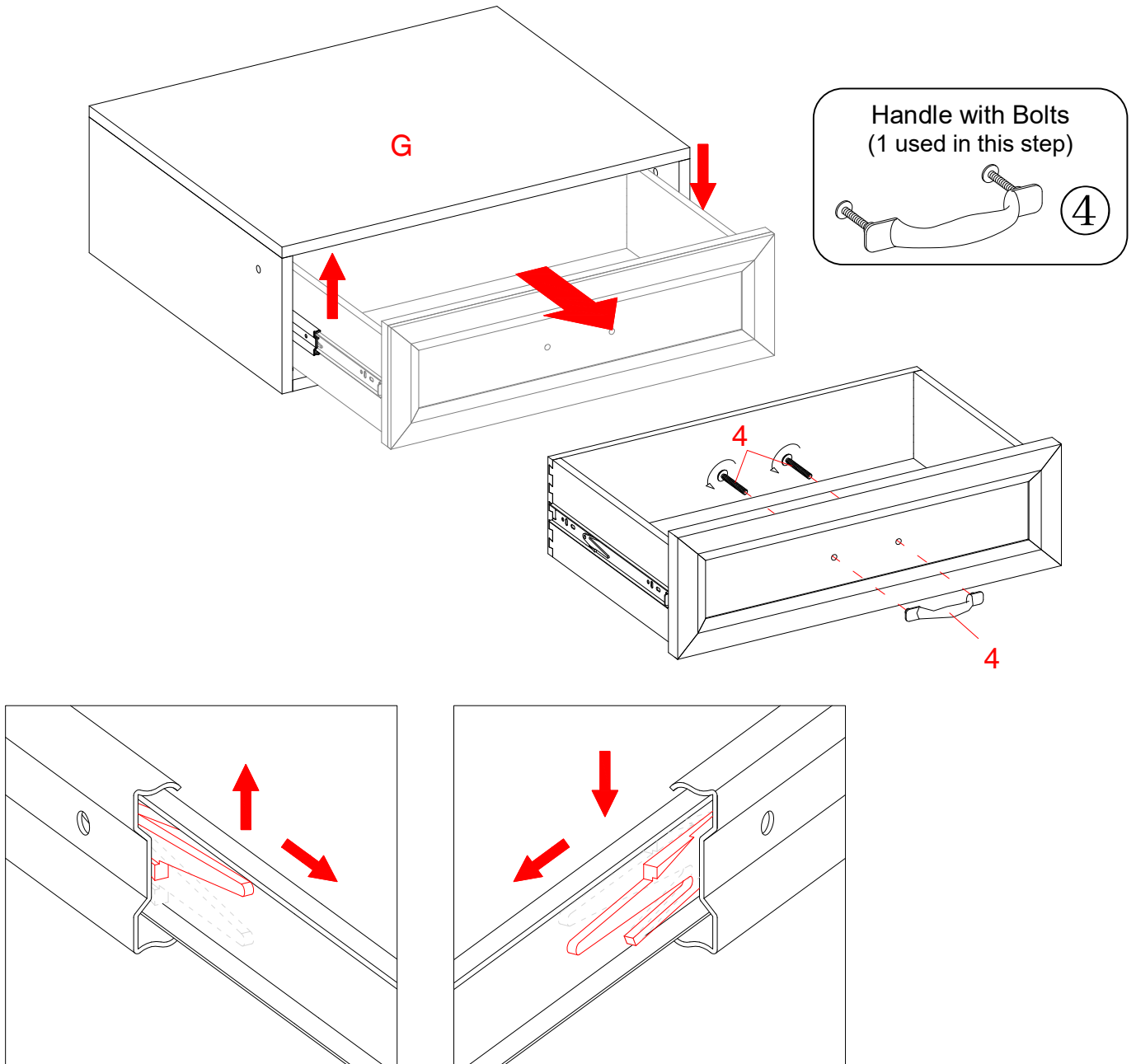
1. Unpack the unit and confirm that you have all the hardware and required parts.
2. Hold the Left Leg and Spine Assembly (A) upright and simply swing the left leg outward. Align and attach the side rails of Right Leg (B) to the back rails of Spine Assembly (A) with three 1/2" Bolts (1).

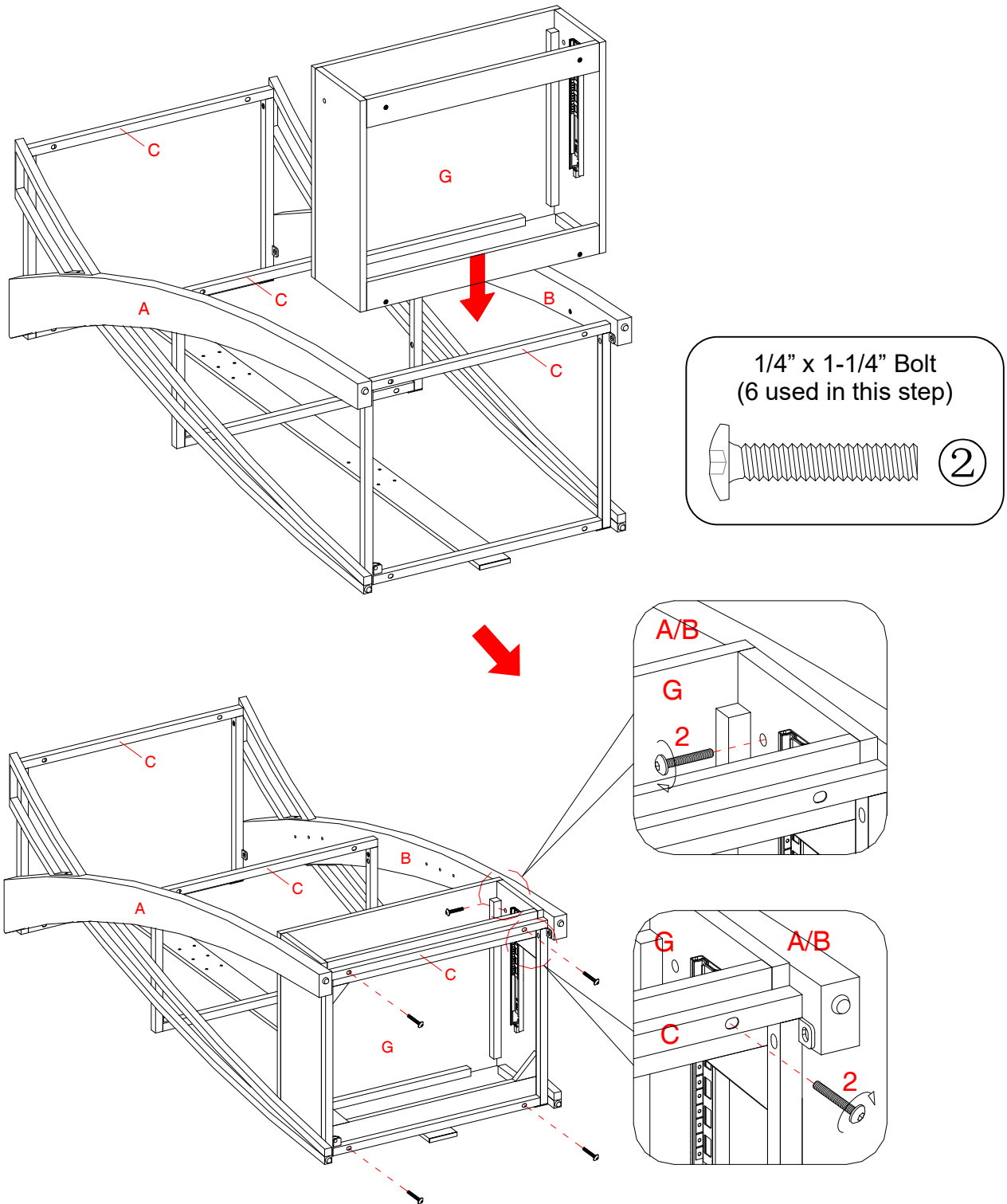
3. Fit the U-shaped bracket on the three Front Stretchers (C) into the side rails of the leg assemblies with six 1/2" Bolts (1).

4. Locate the Drawer Box (G) on a scratch free surface as shown.
5. Pull the utility drawer all the way out, then simultaneously push the plastic release lever of the ball bearing slide up on one side and down on the other side, and then pull the drawers completely out.
6. Remove the bolts in the Handle (4), then use the bolts to attach the Handle to the outside of the utility drawer.

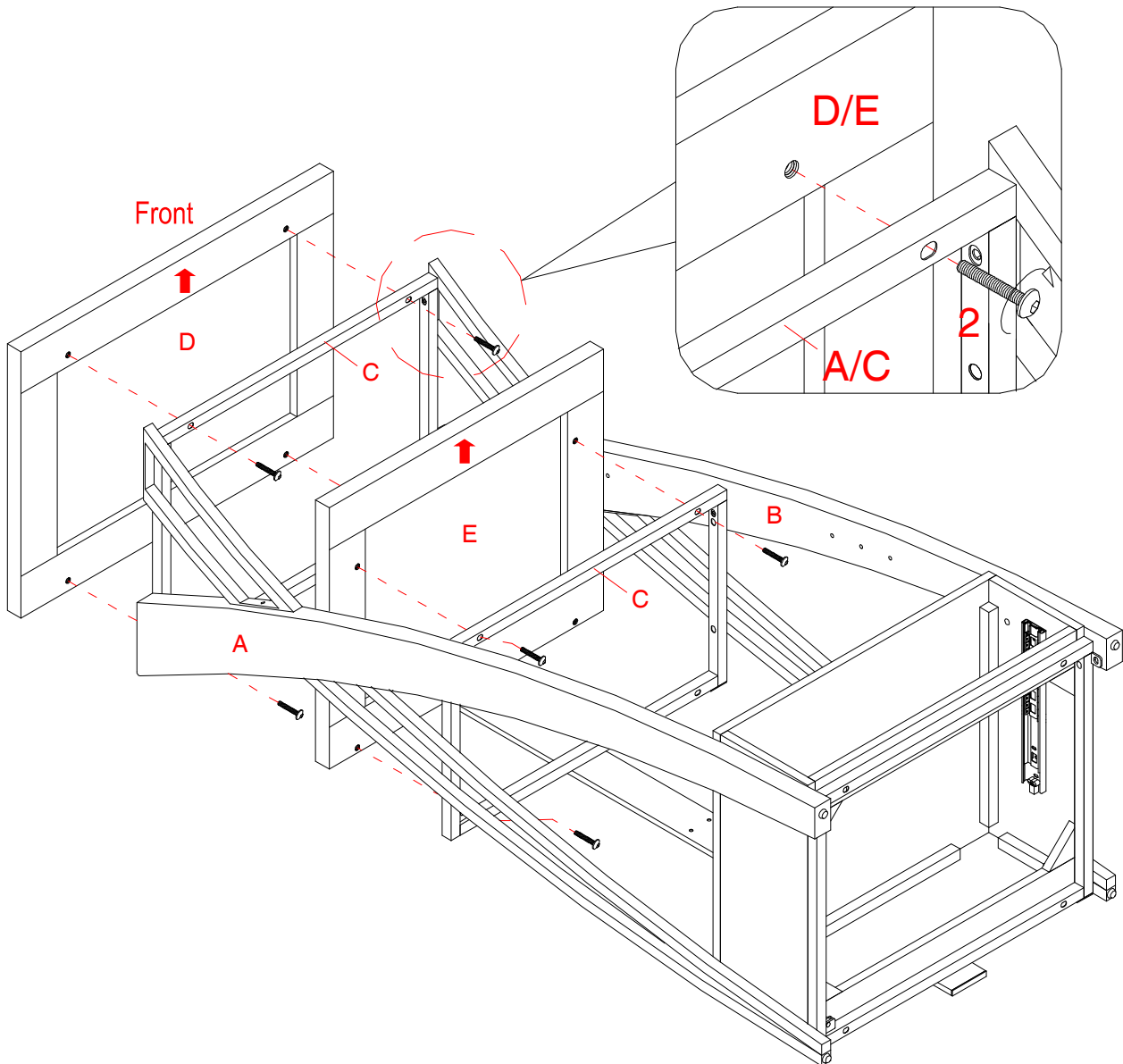

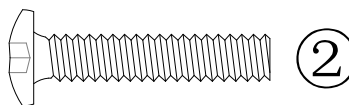
7. Turn the assembled tower frame at its back edge.

8. Fit the Drawer Box (G) between the legs and press firmly to the bottom metal frame. Fasten the Drawer Box (G) in place with six 1-1/4" Bolts (2).

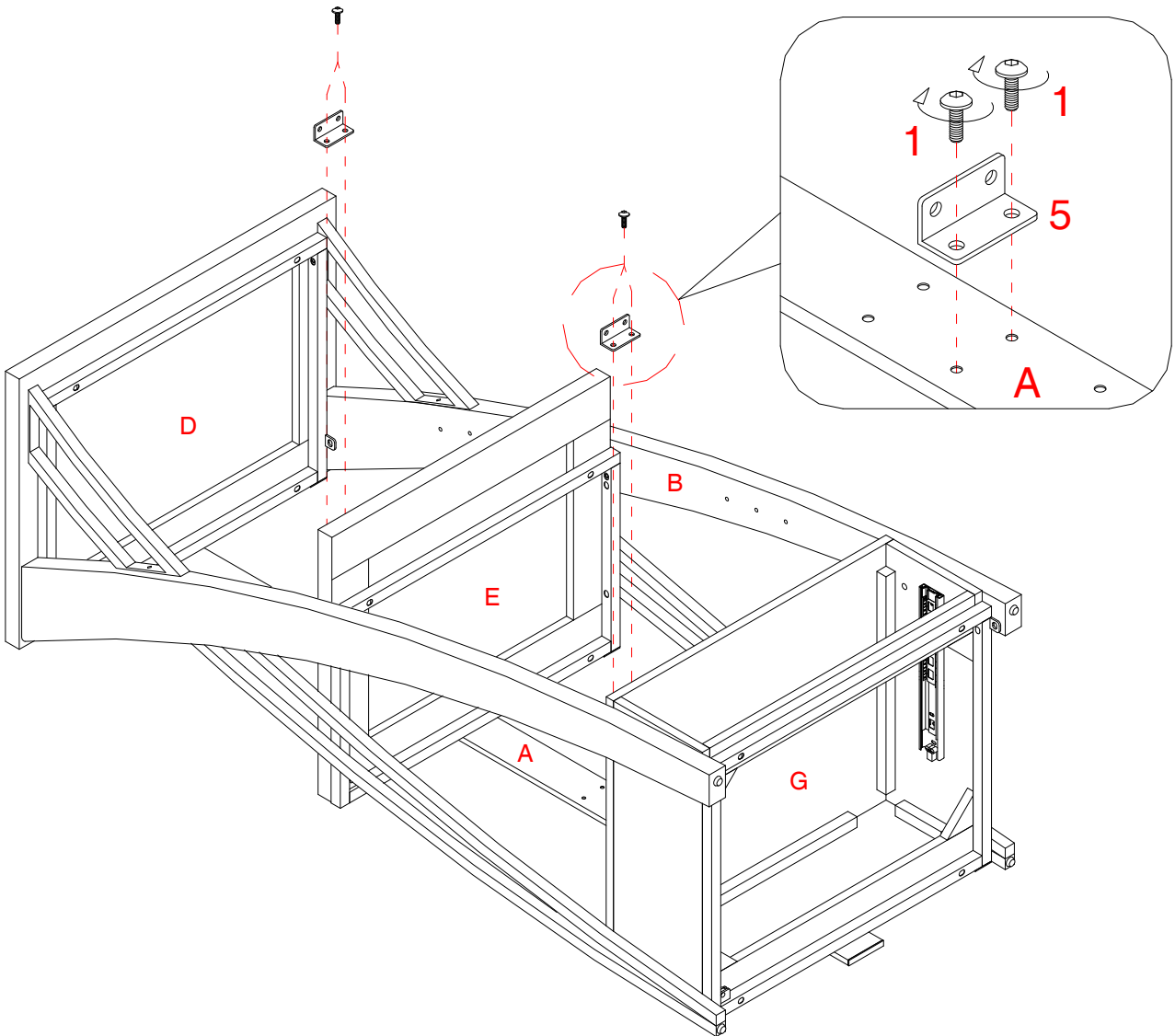

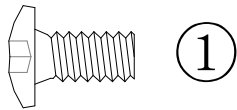


9. Fit the Top Panel (D) and Middle Fixed Shelf (E) onto the assembled shelf frames properly so that the threaded inserts underneath shelf overlap the drilled holes on the Shelf Frames. Insert four 1-1/4" Bolts (2) through the drilled holes and securely screw into each shelf.

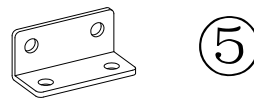

10. Fasten two Metal Brackets (5) to the Spine (A) at the desired height using four 1/2" Bolts (1). Make sure that the right-angle side of Metal Bracket will face upward when the unit is turned upright.

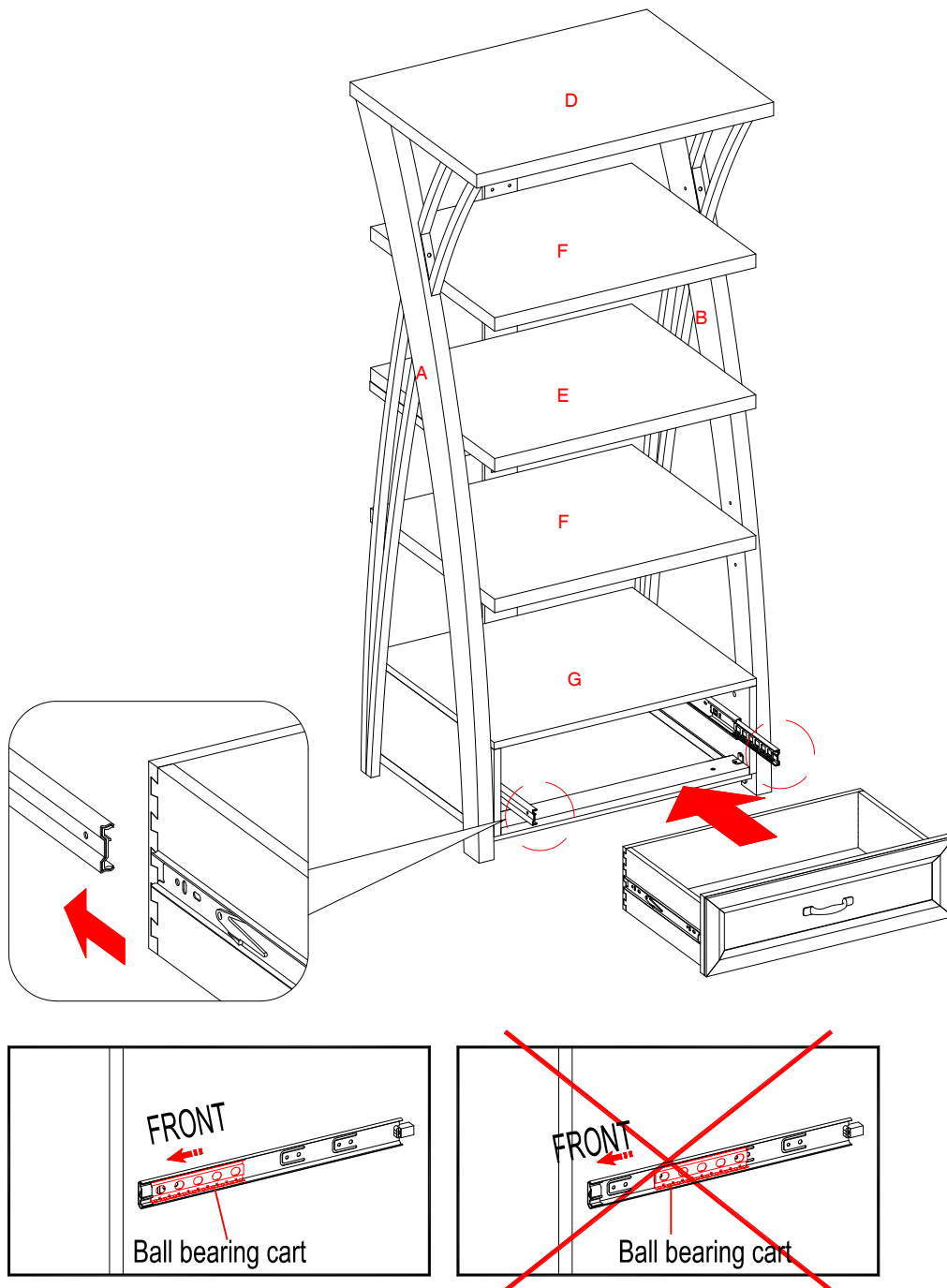
NOTE: The shelf holder location is adjustable. Choose the upper hole sets to increase the lower shelf space.

11. Insert four Shelf Pins (3) into the proper hole sets on the inner side of legs. Be sure the Shelf Pins and the installed Metal Brackets (5) are at the same level, so that they will hold the Shelves (F) properly.
12. Rest the Shelves (F) onto the installed Shelf Pines (3) and Metal Brackets (5). Fasten the Shelves (F) in place with two 1/2" Bolts (1) per bracket.

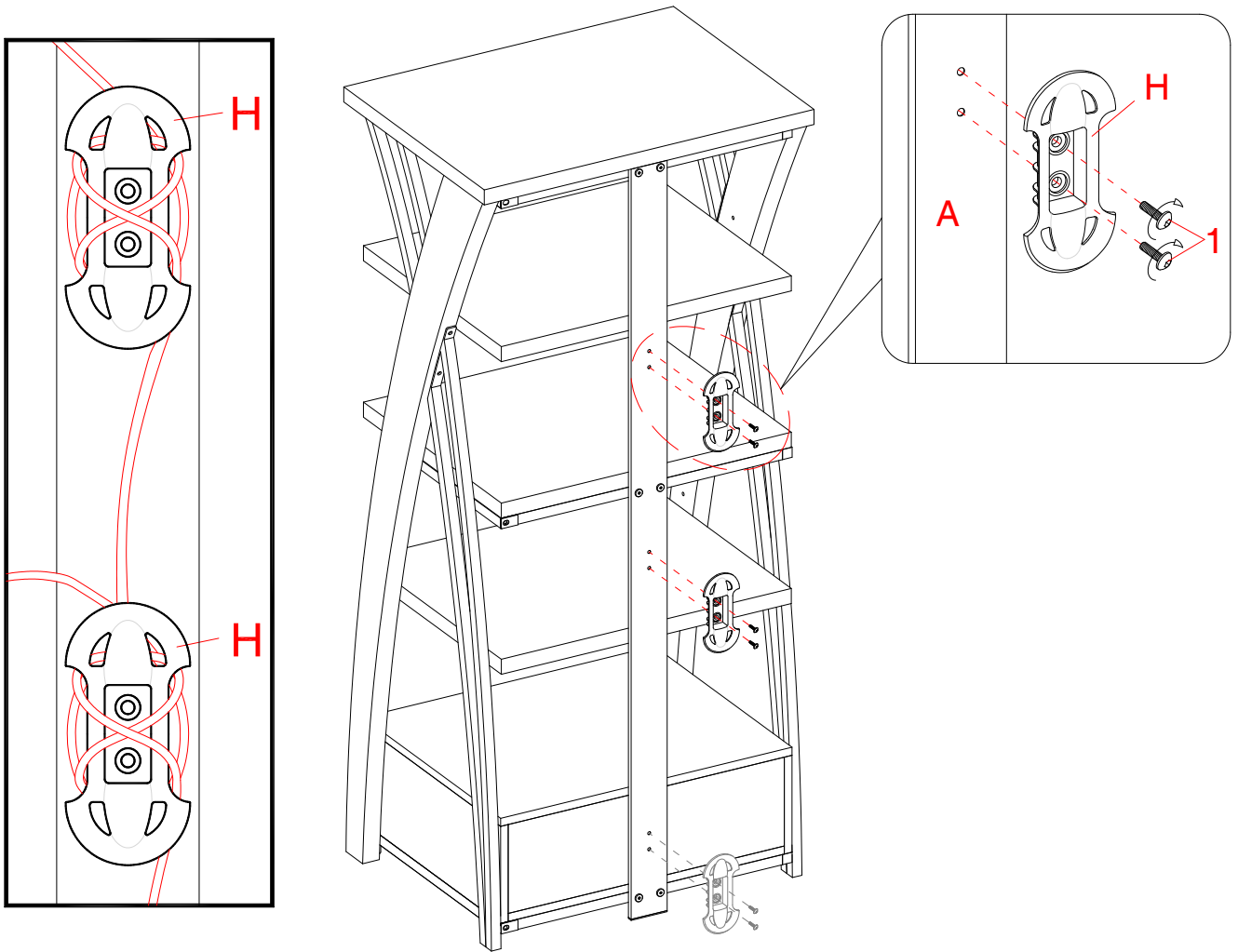

13. Go back and securely tighten all the bolts with the enclosed hex wrench. Ask for assistance to stand the unit upright.

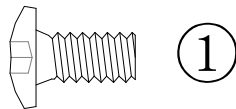
14. Insert the removed drawer into the Drawer Box (G). To place the drawer back, simply push the ball bearing cart all the way to the end of the slides (in both sides), and then align the slide runners on the drawer with the slide tracks on the unit and push it carefully inside until it stops.
NOTE: If the drawer does not go in smoothly, please take it out and repeat the step.

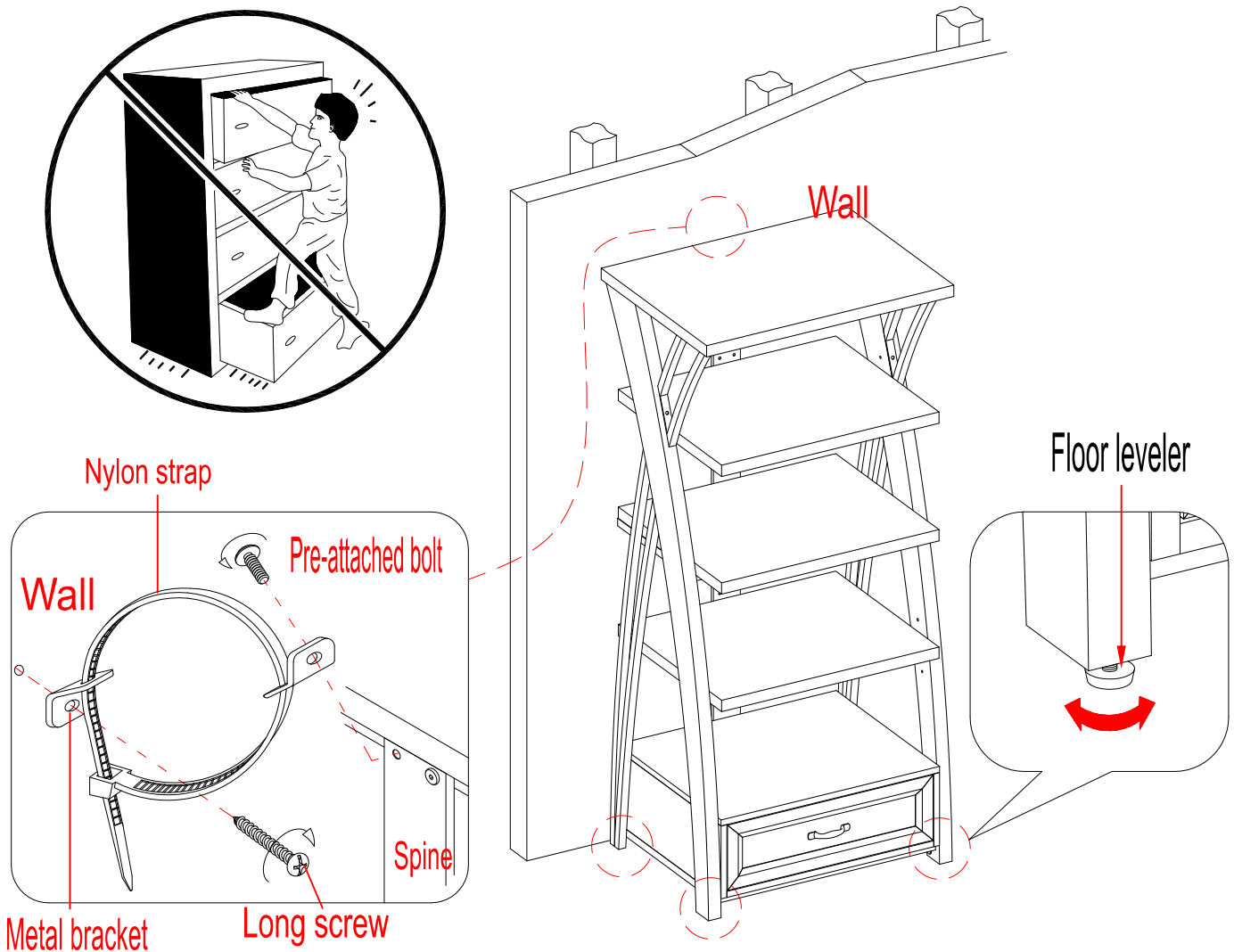

15. Attach two Cable Wheels (H) to the backside of the Spine (A) with four 1/2" Bolts (1). Tighten the bolts with the enclosed hex wrench.

NOTE: You can use the Cable Wheels to help keep your entertainment center's cables and cords organized.

Tools required: Hex wrench (provided), Phillips screwdriver, mallet, power drill, and 1/8" drill bit.

16. Position the assembled unit at the desired location against a wall. If necessary, adjust the pre-attached Floor Levelers at the bottom of the Legs to level the unit. Now, follow the instructions printed on the plastic bag containing the Tipping Restraint Hardware to attach the tip-over restraint to the unit and the wall.

NOTE: The tipping restraint hardware included is for wooden stud wall construction. It must be attached to a wall stud. Depending upon your wall construction, different anchor hardware maybe required. Please contact your local hardware store for assistance. Young children can be seriously injured by tipping furniture. You must install the Tipping Restraint Hardware with the unit to prevent the unit from tipping, causing any accidents or damage. The tipping restraints are intended only as a deterrent, they are not a substitute for proper adult supervision. The tipping restraints are not earthquake restraints. If you wish to add the extra security of earthquake restraints, they must be purchased and installed separately.

17. The unit is now ready for use.

Care and Maintenance

- Use a soft, clean cloth that will not scratch the surface when dusting.
- Use of furniture polish is not necessary. Should you choose to use polish, test first in an inconspicuous area.
- Using solvents of any kind on your furniture may damage the finish.
- Never use water to clean your furniture as it may cause damage to the finish.
- Always use coasters under beverage glasses and flowerpots.
- Liquid spills should be removed immediately. Using a soft, clean cloth, blot the spill gently. Avoid rubbing.
- Always use protective pads under hot dishes and plates. Heat can cause chemical changes that may create spotting within the furniture finish.
- Stains or marks from crayons or ink markers will be difficult to remove.
- In the event that your furniture is stained or otherwise damaged during use, we recommend that you call a professional to repair your furniture.
- Check bolts/screws periodically and tighten them if necessary.

Further Advice about Wood Furniture Care

It is best to keep your furniture in a climate-controlled environment. Extreme temperature and humidity changes can cause fading, warping, shrinking and splitting of wood. It is advised to keep furniture away from direct sunlight as sun may damage the finish.

Proper care and cleaning at home will extend the life of your purchase. Following these important and helpful tips will enhance your furniture as it ages.

A touch-up pen has been provided to minimize the small nicks or scratches that may occur during assembly or shipping.
