

### WARNING



Children have died from furniture tipover.

To reduce the risk of furniture tipover:

- ALWAYS install tipover restraint provided.

- NEVER open more than one drawer at a time.
- Place heaviest items in the lowest drawers.

Use of tip-over restraints may only reduce, but not eliminate, the risk of tip-over.








Screw cam bolt into panel




Push cam into panel - arrow feature on cam top points to panel edge




Align cam bolt(s) with cam(s) and insert all the way into cross-bored hole(s)

Rotate cam(s) clockwise 190°-230° to lock panels together






4.1. Slide one drawer bottom panel (O) into the grooves between the drawer side panels (L and M) until fully inserted into the groove of the drawer front (K).

**NOTE:** Make sure that the drawer bottom panel (O) fits securely into the groove of the drawer back panel (N).



  14.2. Insert 38 mm screws through the countersunk holes on one side stretcher (D) and securely screw into the left side frame (B).





- 15.2. Make sure that the drainage hole on the side handle faces the floor.

### step 16. attach side stretcher to right side frame



<sup>16.1.</sup> Attach two large wood dowels as a guide.

<sup>16.2.</sup> Insert 38 mm screws through the countersunk holes on the other side stretcher (D) and securely screw into the right side frame (X).

# step 17. attach top front rail to front stretcher

(H12) x 4 12 mm screw G The surfaces are flush

17.1. Using the pilot holes as a guide, attach using 12 mm screws in the metal tabs of top front rail (H).


# step 18. attach bottom rails to bottom shelf

(C) (H12) x 8 12 mm screw (H12) The top surfaces are flush

- 18.1. Align the bottom rails (W) so that the mounting holes overlap the pilot holes on the bottom shelf (C). Make sure the top surfaces are flush with each other.
- 18.2. Attach using 12 mm screws into the mounting holes on the bottom rails.

### step 19. attach top back rail to back panel and screw-in cam bolts








- 19.1. Using the pilot holes as a guide, attach the back rail (E) to the back panel (F) using 12 mm screws.
- 19.2. Flip around the back panel (F) and screw-in the cam bolts into the designated holes.



- 20.1. Align fixed shelf (U) to back panel (F) using two large wood dowels as a guide.
- 20.2. Combine the fixed shelf (U) and the back panel (F) into place by engaging three large cam locks.


### step 21. attach the previous assembly between side frames

(H1) (H1) x 12  $(H4) \times 8$ large cam lock large wood dowel **B** 

- 21.1. Align and attach fixed shelf and back panel assembly to left side frame (B) with four large wood dowels and four large cam locks.
- 21.2. Attach the front stretcher (G) to left side frame (B) by engaging two large cam locks. Be sure the front rail (H) faces the front of unit.
- 21.3. Fix the assembled bottom shelf (C) onto the bottom rail of left side frame (B) properly.
- 21.4. Repeat the same procedure to attach right side frame (X) at the opposite end.


### step 22. attach bottom shelf to side frames

- 22.1. Insert 15 mm bolts with washers through the mounting holes on the bottom rails of side frames (B and X) and screw into the bottom shelf (C).
- 22.2. Do not over tighten the bolts.

### step 23. attach top panel to the unit




- 23.1. Place the top panel (A) upside down on a carpeted floor or the empty carton to avoid any scratch.
- 23.2. Flip over the previous assembly and align to the top panel (A) properly.
- 23.3. Insert 30 mm bolts with washers through the mounting holes on both side stretchers (D) and screw into the threaded insert on the top panel (A).

## step 24. attach casters to side frames


 $24.1. \ Securely \ fasten \ the \ casters \ (V) \ to \ the \ bottom \ of \ side \ frames \ (B \ and \ X) \ using \ the \ provided \ open \ wrench.$ 

### step 25. install drawer kits to the unit



- 25.1. Ask for help to lift the unit upright.
- 25.2. To insert the assembled drawers into the frame, simply push the ball bearing cart all the way to the end of the slides (on both sides), and align the slide runners on the drawers with the slides track on the unit. Push it carefully inside until it stops.
  - NOTE: If the drawer does not go smoothly, please take it out and repeat the step

### step 26. install the tip-over restraint hardware kits



Tools required: Phillips screwdriver, stud finder, tape measure, pencil, power drill and 1/8" drill bit (not provided).

- 26.1. Position the assembled unit at the desired location against a wall and adjust the casters in different direction to prevent sliding.
- 26.2. Follow the instructions printed on plastic bag containing tipping restraint hardware to attach tip-over restraint between the unit and wall.

  NOTE: You must use this tipping restraint to attach this unit to the wall, to prevent accidents and/or injures.

#### **Care and Maintenance**

- Use a soft, clean cloth that will not scratch the surface when dusting.
- Use of furniture polish is not necessary. Should you choose to use polish, test first in an inconspicuous area.
- Using solvents of any kind on your furniture may damage the finish.
- Never use water to clean your furniture as it may cause damage to the finish.
- Always use coasters under beverage glasses and flowerpots.
- Liquid spills should be removed immediately. Using a soft, clean cloth, blot the spill gently. Avoid rubbing.
- Always use protective pads under hot dishes and plates. Heat can cause chemical changes that may create spotting within the furniture finish.
- Stains or marks from crayons or ink markers will be difficult to remove.
- In the event that your furniture is stained or otherwise damaged during use, we recommend that you call a professional to repair your furniture.
- Check bolts/screws and nuts periodically and tighten them if necessary.
