



Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from furniture tip-over. To help prevent tip-over:




- Install tip-over restraint provided.
- Place heaviest items in the lowest drawers.
- Do not set TV's or other heavy objects on top of this product, unless the product is specifically designed to accommodate them.
- Never allow children to climb or hang on drawers, doors, or shelves.
- Never open more than one drawer at a time.

Use of tip-over restraints may only reduce, but not eliminate, the risk of tip-over.






step 1.



Screw-in the cam bolts on top panel (A), bottom front molding (F) and the legs (C and D).


step 2.



The notch faces the front of the unit **G** (H3) x 2 M8 x 30 mm wood dowel (H4) x 2 M4 x 50 mm flat head screw \blacksquare


Attach the partition panel (G) to the bottom panel (E).

step 4.




Align and attach the assembled bottom panel (E) between the legs (C and D).

step 5.



Attach the upper front stretcher (L) to the top panel (A). Using the pilot holes as a guide, attach two door stoppers to the upper front stretcher (L).

step 6.




Attach the assembled top panel (A) to the previous assembly. Securely screw the center support (K) to the bottom panel (E) and set the floor leveler in the correct height.

(H7) x 24 M3.5 x 15 mm

washer head screw








Flip around the assembled unit at its front edges.


Unfold and lay the back panel (B) to the backside of the previous assembly. Make sure that the overlaps on the panels are even all the way around. Fasten the back panel (B) into place with the provided screws, using the pilot holes on the top panel as a guide.

NOTE: We recommend attaching the back panel with the screws at the corners first.

step 8.




Using the pilot holes as a guide, extend the hinges if necessary and rest the hinge cups onto the cutouts of the doors (H and I) and secure them in place.




Plug the cam lock covers onto the visible cam locks to conceal the cams.

Insert eight shelf supports into the desired holes inside each compartment. Make sure you place the four shelf supports in the same level so the shelf is not tilted. Tilt and rest the adjustable shelves (J) onto the shelf supports.

step 10.



- 1. To adjust door forward or backward.
- 2. To adjust door to left or to right.
- 3. To adjust door up or down.




Stand the unit upright.


Align and attach the outer doors (H) to the legs (C and D) and attach the inner doors (I) to the partition panel (G).

Open and close the doors to make sure they are aligned and shut correctly. If necessary, adjust the bolts on the hinge arms for better fit.

step 11.



(H12) x 2 tipping restraint hardware kit (inside plastic bag)



Tools required (not provided): Phillips screwdriver, stud finder, measure tape, pencil, power drill and 1/8" drill bit.

Long screw

Nylon strap

Adjust the pre-attached floor levelers to level the unit against a wall. Follow the instructions printed on plastic bag containing tipping restraint hardware to attach tip-over restraint between the unit and wall.

NOTE: You must use this tipping restraint to attach this unit to the wall, to prevent accidents and/or injures.

Metal bracket

Care and Maintenance

- Use a soft, clean cloth that will not scratch the surface when dusting.
- Use of furniture polish is not necessary. Should you choose to use polish, test first in an inconspicuous area.
- Using solvents of any kind on your furniture may damage the finish.
- Never use water to clean your furniture as it may cause damage to the finish.
- Always use coasters under beverage glasses and flowerpots.
- Liquid spills should be removed immediately. Using a soft, clean cloth, blot the spill gently. Avoid rubbing.
- Always use protective pads under hot dishes and plates. Heat can cause chemical changes that may create spotting within the furniture finish.
- Stains or marks from crayons or ink markers will be difficult to remove.
- In the event that your furniture is stained or otherwise damaged during use, we recommend that you call a professional to repair your furniture.
- Check bolts/screws and nuts periodically and tighten them if necessary.

Further Advice about Wood Furniture Care

It is best to keep your furniture in a climate-controlled environment. Extreme temperature and humidity changes can cause fading, warping, shrinking and splitting of wood. It is advised to keep furniture away from direct sunlight as sun may damage the finish.

Proper care and cleaning at home will extend the life of your purchase. Following these important and helpful tips will enhance your furniture as it ages.
